Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school.

Our main curriculum focus this term is around investigating the local area. This topic will be geography led, but will also include ICT and art. In science we will be exploring sound, finding out more about how sound travels and how we can change sounds.

Spellings will be given out on Monday and tested fortnightly on a Friday. Children will be encouraged to focus on a range of spelling patterns, not just the specific words given in a list. Homework will be issued on Tuesday each week and will be taken in the following Monday. This weekly homework will alternate between maths and English. Children are also expected to spend time learning their times tables as directed by their teacher.

Further to this, we also ask that you continue to read regularly with your child and make a record of this in their reading record. The fortnightly 'reading raffle' will continue through the year once again. Every child who has their reading record signed at least four times during the week will receive a token, with each class drawing a winner who is able to select a book prize during our celebration assembly. Children will need their full PE kits and will require a kit for both outdoor and indoor PE lessons. PE lessons will take place on:
