Welcome back to school.

Our Geography project this term will see us researching the Veneto. We are sure that the children will be fascinated by this interesting area of Italy. Our art this half term will also be linked to this, as we are investigating art and design during the Renaissance. In science we will be exploring evolution, finding out more about how living things on earth have changed over time.
