Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school. We are looking forward to working with your children as they embark on their final year at Belmont. We appreciate that Year Six can be very stressful and hope that you will help us support your child to develop and progress confidently.

Our Geography project this term will see us researching the Veneto. We are sure that the children will be fascinated by this interesting area of Italy. Our art this half term will also be linked to this, as we are investigating art and design during the Renaissance.
